### Christ's Love Is Alive in Us!

During the Easter Season, we will celebrate that Christ's love is alive!

We celebrate that Jesus Christ's love is alive by lifting the verse in John's Gospel (15:5), which teaches us that we do not stand alone in our faith walk because, together, we abide in the vine of Christ. In that, being part of the vine teaches us that Christ's love is alive in us!

Another example of Christ's love is shared in the story about a man who watched a group of workers tear down an old building. He also watched a large ball swing from a crane and repeatedly pound into the walls. And he asked the foreman, "Are these men skilled, or do they need special training to tear down this building?"



"No," replied the foreman, "what these men can tear down in a day or two, it took builders who are skilled in each of their crafts a year or more to build." This story teaches us that to build and grow, we need to nurture our faith in God, as well as nurture our love towards one another.

Christ-like love also suggests that we spend our time lifting one another with kindness and acts of mercy. Christ-like love gives us hope and helps us flourish in our prayerful efforts toward peace and justice for all!

Paul also explains the importance of Christ's love when he writes to the Corinthians, "Love is patient and kind; love is not jealous or boastful, it is not arrogant or rude. Love does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful, it does not rejoice at wrong but rejoices in the right. Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, and endures all things. Love never ends." In other words, love meets a person right where they are, for who they are, accepts a person, and then gives the person the freedom to grow and mature in themselves and in Christ. This is how Jesus Christ's love lives in us. During this Easter Season, we will celebrate the love of Jesus Christ, whose love has the power to shine upon and through us all!

#### **Prayer**





#### 2025 Nehemiah Action Assembly

#### AFFORDABLE HOUSING:

Everyone deserves a safe place to call home. However that is not a reality for the estimated 105,000 families that are paying more than 30% of their income towards rent. There is currently a deficit of 42,500 affordable apartments for those making below \$59,000. Counties such as Broward and Hillsborough are addressing this crisis through an Affordable Rental Housing Trust Fund. PEACE is pushing for Palm Beach County to establish and AHTF that prioritizes building rental apartments for those making below \$59,000 annually. At the Nehemlah Action, Housing and Economic Development Director Jonathan Brown agreed to support PEACE's efforts to create more affordable apartments and to review our proposal.



Each year, thousands of African-American and Hispanic residents of Palm Beach
County experience "investigatory" stops for minor things like rolling stops or light
too dim on the license plate. These stops are more about investigating the driver and
their passenger(s). People of color feel targeted, leading to growing mistrust of the
police. At the 2024 Nehemiah Action, we reaffirmed Sheriff Ric Bradshaw's
commitment to track and analyze data on all traffic stops, including those that resul
in verbal warnings. He also agreed to contract with Dr. McDevitt to analyze this
data. Lastly, Sheriff Bradshaw agreed to meet with PEACE within 45 days to
implement data collection now using the system he currently has. We will send out
that meeting data ASAP.

#### MENTAL HEALTH:

In 2020, 48,790 adults suffered from a serious mental illness in Palm Beach County, but only 46% received help. Florida Assertive Community Treatment (FACT) teams address this gap in access to services, but Palm Beach County only has one and a half teams serving just 126 individuals. PEACE is calling on Ann Berner and South East Florida Behavioral Network to fund and manage an additional FACT team, to serve the thousands of others who deserve care. As the managing entity, SEFBHN receives millions of dollars annually from the state to address behavioral health in the Palm Beaches and the Treasure Coast. At our 2024 Nehemiah Action, Ms. Berner refused to fund an additional team. We are frustrated that Ann Berner and SEFBHN are not making Palm Beach County's mental health a priority. PEACE is not going to stop flighting and will continue following up with Ms. Berner because Palm Beach County needs care... not crisis.


